USES

- Members can register for events and pay for them online.
- Members can make online contributions and view the details of their prior contributions.
- Small Group Management allows staff and leaders to track members from initial point of interest all the way through connection or assignment into a group.
- Leaders can view rosters of their groups, send group e-mail, and mark attendance online.
- Pastors can look up scheduled connections tasks and enter comments when completed without returning to the office.
- Pastors can manage their ministry teams by easily seeing the assigned contacts and which team members have not completed their tasks. They can also print various rosters and e-mail teams information for upcoming meetings.
- Approved users can view selected church calendars and submit requests for rooms and equipment.
- The administrator can review all change requests and calendar requests before accepting changes into ACS People™, ACS Connections™, or The Ministry Scheduler™

FEATURES

Password-Protected Access

- All users must sign in with a user name and password before they can view any data.
- The administrator creates the staff user accounts and sets up their passwords. (Staff can then change their own passwords.)
- When member users first register for Access ACS, they must enter their first name, last name, suffix (if they have one) and e-mail address as entered in ACS People. The member is then sent an e-mail with the user name and password.
- You may set up an unlimited number of user profiles to be used as permissions for various types of users. (such as Elders, Finance Committee, Ministry Leaders, and Members).

Hardware and Software Security

- All transactions in Access ACS use encryption technology such as 128-bit Secure Socket Layer (SSL) to transmit information between you, your members, and Access ACS.
- The Access ACS servers are located in a secure, state-of-the-art data center facility.
- Backups are done periodically and stored offsite.
- Firewalls and intrusion detection block unauthorized access.
