

During the monthly Session meeting on January 23, 2023

- Eleanor Shell and Elder Chuck Bohlen reported on the ongoing Stewardship campaign.
- Vicki Smith, representing the Committee on Ministry of the Presbytery of Charlotte, was present to report on the exit interviews conducted with Rev Katie Harrington and our Session regarding Rev Harrington's departure. All comments were positive.
- Elder Carol Apel reported on the status of a 2023 budget. It will be completed soon and presented to Session during the month of February.
- Session approved a recommendation from the Administration Ministry and the Property Commission to modify our "van rules and regulations" to revise the maximum age of drivers from 72 to 75.
